Driving Directions to Fort Benning Conference Center

Take I-185 S to the Fort Benning Visitor's Center for vehicle pass. From the Visitor Center continue on 185 until the road forks. Stay in the right lane and continue to Ingersoll Avenue. Turn right onto Ingersoll Avenue. Continue straight until Pearman Street. Make a right and continue to Morrison Avenue. Conference center will be on the right.

Please allow extra time to get through the gate. Visitors must stop at the Visitor's Center Main Gate I-185 to obtain a vehicle pass. Visitors will need vehicle registration; vehicle year, make, model and color; license plate number, state and expiration; and picture ID.
