Reminders for a Successful Year:

• Daily Attendance Matters

Consistent attendance is crucial to academic success. Please ensure your student is present and on time each day. If your student must be absent, be sure to notify the attendance office as soon as possible.

• Keep Contact Information Up to Date

Please verify and update your phone numbers, email addresses, and emergency contacts in PowerSchool. This helps us communicate important information throughout the year.

• Check PowerSchool Regularly

PowerSchool is your go-to resource for staying informed about your student's grades, attendance, and progress. We encourage you to check it regularly and reach out to teachers with any questions.

Morning Arrival & Drop-Off Procedures:

- **Building Entry:** Students may enter the building through the front main entry at **7:30 AM**, unless there is inclement weather when we will open the doors at 7:00 AM.
- Breakfast is available from 7:30 AM until 7:45 AM.
- Class Start Time: Classes begin promptly at 7:50 AM. Please ensure your student arrives on time.
- Student Drop-Off: Use the outside lanes to drop off your student. The two inside lanes are for through traffic only. This system ensures both safety and a smooth traffic flow.

Lunch Period Expectations (pg. 5 of the Student & Family Handbook):

- Students without off-campus lunch privileges (approved seniors only) are expected to remain on campus during lunch.
- Parents or guardians may not call to excuse a student solely to leave campus for lunch.
- Students may only leave during lunch for **pre-approved special occasions**—requests must be made **at least 24 hours in advance** and approved by school administration.
- These guidelines are in place to **protect student safety** and maintain accountability during the school day.
