PSAT/NMSQT

The PSAT, which qualifies students for the National Merit Scholarship, will be on Tuesday, October 14th at The Welcome Center during the school day. We will provide Transportation.

To register, students need to bring \$20 to Mrs. Strawn or Mrs. Hadley in the Counseling Office by Friday, September 6th. Only Sophomores and Juniors are allowed to take the test.

When: October 14th at the Welcome Center. Transportation will be provided.

What is the PSAT/NMSQT exam?

The PSAT/NMSQT exam assesses the academic skills that students have developed over the years, primarily through their coursework. These skills are considered essential for success in high school, college, and career. The PSAT is co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation. You must take the PSAT in 11th grade in order to be considered for the National Merit Scholarship Program.
