Our City

The Bellevue/Offutt Community was the first settlement in Nebraska. It was settled in the 1830's, incorporated in 1855, and has grown to the present community of over 64,000. Bellevue borders the southern part of Omaha and is home of Offutt Air Force Base and the United States Strategic Command. Approximately 26% of our students are dependents of military or civilian personnel working on the base.

Our School

Bellevue East, one of two high schools in the Bellevue Public Schools, has an enrollment of about 1,400 students. It is a comprehensive high school offering courses to meet students' needs in academic, vocational, and cooperative education. Approximately 68% of our graduates go on to post-secondary education. Bellevue East is accredited by the Nebraska Department of Education and Cognia, a global accreditation agency.

Graduation Requirements

Beginning with the Class of 2025, students must earn a minimum of 50 credits to graduate.

Advanced and Advanced Placement Courses

Bellevue East offers 9 Advanced Courses which include: American History A, English 9A, English 10A, Chemistry A, Biology A, Geometry A, Algebra IIA, and Pre Calculus A.

Nineteen Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered: 2-D Art and Design AP, 3-D Art and Design AP, Drawing AP, Biology AP, AB Calculus AP, BC Calculus AP, Chemistry AP, A Computer Science AP, Computer Science Principles AP, English 11 AP, English 12 AP, Physics 1 AP, Physics 2 AP, Psychology AP, Spanish V, Statistics AP, United States Government AP, United States History AP, World History AP, AP Economics.

Bellevue East also offers eighteen Dual Enrolled courses through UNO. These include Calculus AP AB, Calculus AP BC, Statistics AP, English 12 AP, American Government AP, Economics AP, Sociology AP, Psychology AP, Biology AP, Physics AP 1, Physics AP 2, Spanish V, Spanish IV, French III, French IV Sports Medicine. Metro also offers Concurrent Enrollment classes. These courses are German III, German IV/V, Calculus AP AB, Calculus AP BC, Statistics AP, Pre-Calculus Advanced, American History AP, American Government/American Government AP, Anatomy & Physiology, Medical Terminology, Health Science, Spanish III, Spanish IV, English 11 AP, Trigonometry, AP Economics, Spanish V, Construction I and II, Sociology.

Project Recovery

The Acellus program is designed to help students earn credit in core classes previously failed. It is used only if students are severally behind on credits to graduate. For more information, please contact the counseling department.
