# Sending Transcripts/Act Scores to College

- •A transcript release **must** be submitted by parent/guardian (or student if 18 years of age)
- Students can request transcripts be sent to colleges/scholarships. Students/parents can request a copy of transcript for college, scholarships,
- insurance.
  - Release form is available on the school's website, and in an email sent
    - to parents in August.
- •Note: Some schools do not require an initial transcript but instead require students to self-report: e.g. UNL, UNO, UNK
