- **You may choose from any of the Enrichment or Physical Education classes**

### Academic/Fine Arts Enrichment

#### **Number Ninjas**

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Math.  
Offered: Periods 1, 2, 3, or 4

#### **Reading Strategies**

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Reading.  
Offered: Periods 1, 2, or 3

#### **Writing Strategies**

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Writing.  
Offered: Period 4

#### **Brain Games**

This summer school class will get you having fun and playing games and working your brain!  
Word games, strategy games and more!  
Offered: Period 1 or 2

#### **Moving on to Middle School**

Designed for students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade or new 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. The focus will be on skills and activities essential to success in middle school.  
Offered: Periods 1, 2, 3, or 4

#### **Life Skills**

This class is designed to increase students' knowledge of and ability in using the skills necessary for everyday living. In this class, we will define personal goal-setting and planning, career exploration, daily living skills, and budgeting. Offered: Periods 1 or 2

#### **Book Versus Movie**

A look at short stories and their visual counterparts. Is the movie always better? We will find out. Offered: Period 3

#### **Social Side of Middle School**

Students will learn to sharpen their ability to focus and pay attention, discuss how to experience life situations with less emotional reactivity, learn effective strategies for making better choices, increase kindness and compassion for themselves and others, and learn skills for self care. Offered: Periods 1 or 2

#### **2-D Art**

Students will explore two-dimensional media including drawing, painting, and photography.  
Offered: Periods 1 or 2

#### **3-D Art**

Students will explore three-dimensional media including clay, paper mache, and found object sculpture.  
Offered: Periods 3 or 4

#### **All About Apps**

Students will explore a variety of educational apps. We will discuss appropriate use of iPads in the classroom and practice by creating different projects using technology.  
Offered: Period 3

#### **Kaboom!**

Exploring Comic Books and Graphic Novels  
Read some of our libraries graphic novels and try to write your own! Look at how some comic books have changed over the years.  
Offered: Period 4

#### **Creative Writing**

Writers in this class will express their ideas and thoughts in an imaginative, fun and creative way.  
Offered: Periods 4

#### **Math Fun with Strategic Games**

In this class we will work on some of the most important math skills, logic and strategies. The best way to do this is through games. Students will learn to play a variety of card games, domino games, as well as board games specifically designed for logic. No previous experience or knowledge of games is needed!!  
Offered: Period 1

#### **Engineering**

Students will work in small groups to design and build. Designs may include towers, egg drop, straw rockets, or bottle rockets among others.

#### **Introduction to Automation & Robotics**

Students will learn about the basics of automation and robotics through a variety of projects.  
Offered: Periods 1, 2, 3, or 4

#### **7th Grade Band**

#### **8<sup>th</sup> Grade Band**

Students should have completed one or more years of band. We will work on fundamentals and small group playing.  
Offered: Period 2

#### **Introduction to Jazz Band**

Students must have completed 7<sup>th</sup> grade band. We will work on fundamentals and small group playing.
