#### Tips for a Successful Senior Year

- Monitor Grades/Attendance using the Parent Portal
  - Students need to attend school to be successful
  - Students who do not complete all graduation requirements are not allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Read the School Newsletter (monthly) & email updates (weekly)
- Encourage students to complete applications early & meet deadlines in a timely manner

#### Selective Service Information

- Males who turn 18 years of age are required by law to register with the Selective Service System.
- Registering keeps them eligible for Federal Student Loan Programs, Grants, and Jobs.
- Males can register online, at a post office, by mail, when applying for Financial Aid, or in Bellevue West's Career



#### Sending Transcripts/ACT Scores to a College

- A transcript release must be submitted by parent/guardian (or student if 18 years of age)
- Students can request transcripts be sent out to colleges/scholarships.
- Students/parents can request a copy of transcript for college, scholarships.
- Electronic release form will be made available on the school's website, and distributed via email to parents in August.

Note: Some schools do not require an initial transcript but instead require students to self-report courses/grades.

#### Completing the FAFSA

- Graduation requirement for the Class of 2026
  - Opt out option and process
- Families can apply for financial aid using the FAFSA form beginning likely December 1st. (2024 tax information will be used for this year's senior class)
- Parents and students need to apply for a FSA ID that will be used as their electronic signature for when they file their FAFSA form. We suggest you obtain an FSA ID before beginning the FAFSA form due to 3 day wait period.






- ACE Scholarship—for students who are Free/Reduced applying for dual enrollment

## Applying for College

- Apply on the college's website.

  - Transcripts, application fee, test scores and supplemental materials may be required.
  - Application fee may be waived for students on Free/Reduced lunch. Students should contact their counselor.
- Apply early to make sure all documents are received by the school's application deadline.







### College Admissions Tests

#### 2-Year/Community College (Metro)

- Accuplacer Test—Placement Test, Free, (Test is taken at Metro Testing
   Center—testing is available daily)
- IWCC—No placement test required

#### - 4-Year Colleges

- ACT Test: Offered in Sept., Oct., Dec., Feb., April, June, & July. \$69 for Basic--\$94 Basic + Writing (register at actstudent.org)
- SAT Test: Offered in Aug., Oct., Nov., Dec., Mar., May, & June. \$68 for Basic (register at www.collegeboard.org)
- \*\*Fee waivers are available for the ACT and SAT for students who are on free/reduced lunch. Students should see a counselor for a form if they qualify.


#### Note:

- Most colleges will not accept ACT scores sent from Bellevue West. (UNL, UNO, UNK & the NCAA—scores must be sent directly from ACT)
  - When students sign up for the ACT test, they can list 4 colleges that receive the scores for free.
  - -Students can go on to www.actstudent.org to request scores be sent (if ACT was already taken--\$19 per report).
