Classes will fill on a first-come, first-serve basis. Most classes have a cap on enrollment. Classes with insufficient registration as of May 9th may not be offered.

Attendance:

Students are required to be in attendance every day that summer school is in session. Students who are absent must bring a note explaining the reason for their absence and obtain an admit slip.

Math Strategies

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Math. Offered: Periods 1 or 2

Reading Strategies

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Reading. Offered: Periods 3 or 4

Writing Strategies

Recommended for students who would benefit from improving basic skills in Writing. Offered: Periods 3 or 4

Brain Games

Offered: Periods 1 or 2

2-D Art

Students will create art work using drawing, watercolor, and acrylic painting. Offered: Periods 1 or 2

3-D Art

Students will create art work using clay and wire sculpture. Offered: Periods 3 or 4

Eco Explorers

Are you passionate about nature and the environment? Students in this class will explore hands-on activities, outdoor adventures, and engage in experiments involving our ecosystems. Offered: Periods 1, 2, or 3

3D Design and Printing

Learn how to design and build projects. Use technology like 3D printers and 3D pens to create your designs. We will work in a variety of media during the class. Offered: Period 2

Flight and Space Engineering

Join us as we discover flight through designing, creating, and testing creations for both IN atmosphere and OUT of atmosphere flight. Offered: Period 3

Fun with Math

This class will reinforce a variety of math skills through the use of games, projects, and activities. Offered: Period 3

Creative Writing

Writers in this class will express their ideas and thoughts in an imaginative, fun and creative way. Offered: Periods 2 or 3

Robotics and Programming

Wonder how robots move themselves or how cars can self-drive? In this class we will focus on building different vehicles and exploring various means to program code. Offered: Period 4

Advanced Robotic Programming

Available for students who participated in robotics last summer or in Brave Time this year. We will work on advanced building and programming. Offered: Period 1

Bring your own books from home or borrow from the teacher and participate in discussions and various activities while improving your reading skills. Offered: Period 4

7th Grade Band

(Students entering 7th grade only)

Students should have completed one or more years of band. We will work on fundamentals and small group playing. Offered: Period 1

8th Grade Band

(Students entering 8th grade only)

Students should have completed two or more years of band. We will work on preparing for the East/West game, all-state auditions, and more! Offered: Period 2

Jazz Band

Students must have completed 7th grade band. We will work on fundamentals and small group playing. Offered: Period 4

Team Sports

Students will participate in a variety of sports. Offered: Period 4

Basketball Skills

This class will focus on teaching skills required to become a better player for all skill levels. Offered: Period 3

Baseball/Softball Fundamentals

This class will focus on improving all skill levels. Offered: Period 2

Football Fundamentals

This class will focus on improving all skill levels. Offered: Period 1

Advanced 7th Grade Math:
