- Advantages of Dual Enrollment
 - College credit while in High School
 - Cheaper
 - Chance to try a college level workload while in high school.
- Disadvantages of Dual Enrollment
 - Colleges may not accept a credit or may apply it differently
 - The course may not be the level of challenge you are looking for.
 - Grades are permanent

What if my student isn't doing well in the Dual Enrollment class?

Option to withdraw from the college side of the course.

Metro Withdraw dates:

- Dec. 5th for 1st sem. courses
- May 7th for 2nd sem. or year-long courses

UNO Withdraw dates:

- Nov. 7th for 1st sem. courses
- April 3rd for 2nd sem. courses
- March 27th for year long-courses
